

DRUGS AWARENESS MEETINGS

Today many parents worry about their child becoming involved with drugs. Many youth leaders and coaches are also concerned about young people being exposed to the risks of drugs and substance misuse. However, parents and those working with young people feel they don't know enough about drugs to help prevent our youth from coming to harm.
