The Foundation stone for St Paul's was laid in September 1963 and the Church was practically completed by December 1965. It was used for Masses since the Fourth Sunday of Advent that year. The Church was solemnly dedicated and officially opened by Bishop O'Doherty on Sunday 17th April, 1966. Cardinal William Conway attended this ceremony. Several photographs of that historic day are included in the 2016 commemorative calendar which was produced by St Paul's Parish last Christmas to mark this Golden Jubilee year.

To mark the 50th anniversary of the solemn dedication itself, Bishop McAreavey will celebrate the <u>12noon Mass</u> in St Paul's Church, <u>next Sunday</u> 17th April and any parishioner (from either Lurgan parish) is welcome to attend.

We give thanks, at this time, for the gift that St Paul's Church has been for local people, and for all who have been part of Catholic life in Lurgan, during the past five decades.
