Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June @ 7.25pm. An Historical two-part outing to old Tullylish, and to Laurencetown, Co Down to be conducted by Plunkett Campbell. The meeting point is the prominent Old Tullylish church tower that stands within the elevated, off-road, Tullylish ancient cemetery (now Church of Ireland), on the road that joins Gilford to Laurencetown village.
