**Dromore Diocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage 2023**  
The Dromore Diocese intends to organise a 5-day pilgrimage to Lourdes in May 2023 (exact dates to be confirmed).  
Unfortunately, due to the pandemic it will be a different kind of pilgrimage, as we will not be using the hospital accommodation (Accueil) in Lourdes and will therefore be unable to support an assisted section in 2023. This means we will not have the same support from doctors, nurses, and volunteers as we had pre pandemic.  
The pilgrimage will include general insurance cover (to include Covid 19 cover), transport to/from airports, a programme of ceremonies in Lourdes, assistance of travel agent representatives in Lourdes.
