JOINING OUR LADY AT KNOCK
In normal circumstances, our diocesan pilgrimage to Knock would have been due to take place on Sunday 21 June. While we will not be able to travel this year, the clergy of Knock parish continue to celebrate the Pilgrimage Masses, streamed live from the basilica every Sunday, and they pray for each pilgrim by name that was booked to be there on that given day.
Leading up to our pilgrimage day, there will be a week of prayer to Our Lady of Knock from churches around our diocese, available to all via our webcams from Sunday 14 – Saturday 20 June.
