#### **NEW ARRANGEMENTS FOR SUNDAY MASSES**

We now have had three weeks of Sunday Masses. The numbers attending have been well below our capacity level. The nine areas may have been too restrictive. We now propose to have six areas designated to specific dates and times. The advice to ring the parish office to request a place at Mass did not work, so that plan is now abolished. A family in a specific area may now attend their designated Mass.

The Archbishop continues to extend the dispensation from attending Sunday Mass at this time and attendance at a weekday Mass will fulfil the Sunday obligation. Therefore, please, if possible, think of attending a weekday Mass. This would greatly reduce the expected congregation at the Sunday Masses.

#### Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel

Matthew 13:24-43

- 1. The owner of the field who allowed the wheat and the darnel to grow together is a reminder to us to be patient with ourselves and with others when we see that not everything is right. Sometimes a preoccupation with the negative (the darnel) can blind us to the positive in our own lives and in the lives of others. When have you found that a willingness to live with the messiness of the present created the conditions for future growth?
- 2. Have you ever found that it was through accepting the darnel that you learned important lessons for life, e.g., learning through mistakes, stupid questions, or foolish risks?
- 3. The parables of the mustard seed and the leaven are reminders that seemingly insignificant things can have very positive results. Have you ever been surprised by the benefit to yourself or others of a kind gesture, a small initiative, or a word of encouragement?
