150 years of wonderful service

This weekend we are celebrating, in a special way, the presence of the Sisters of Mercy in Lurgan for 150 years. A group of Sisters first came here on Monday 20th August 1866 - the day which marked, across the Atlantic, the formal ending of the American Civil War. In times very different to our own, the Sisters set about their work with energy and fervour, opening their first schools just three weeks later, on Monday 10th September. The story of their service to Lurgan, across the generations which followed, has been a rich and noble one. We pause to acknowledge this and to give thanks to God for it, at this time.

Bishop McAreavey is celebrating the 6pm Vigil Mass in St Peter's Church, this weekend, as a Mass of Thanksgiving. Refreshments are being served afterwards in St Peter's Hall and Sr Evelyn Kenny, archivist of the Mercy Congregation, will deliver a brief lecture there, summarizing the story of the Sisters in Lurgan since 1866. All parishioners are warmly welcome!

We pray God's continued blessing upon the Sisters of Mercy who live among us in Lurgan, today, and upon all who support and assist them in their daily needs.

Sunday 28th August. A Field trip to the grave in Desertcreat, Co Tyrone, of Bishop Patrick Donnelly, formerly Bishop of Dromore, the 300th anniversary of whose death occurs this year. Often referred to as 'the Bard of Armagh', on account of him travelling around great areas of this land in disguise during harsh Penal Era, Bishop Donnelly was a heroic priest who carried out his Episcopal and priestly duties in the face of constant persecution. The field trip, (a lecture, a discussion and a song), will be led by Tom Keane of Lislea, South Armagh, and will begin in Desertcreat Church of Ireland graveyard a@ 3pm. Bishop Donnelly's brother Bishop Terence Donnelly,

formerly Bishop of Derry, lies in the same grave in this their native place. This event is open to all parishioners, as are all events organised by the Society.
