Ash Wednesday

Next Wednesday, 1st March, is Ash Wednesday and begins the holy season of Lent. It is a day of fast and abstinence for all Catholics.

Ashes will be blessed and distributed during all Masses. Masses in St Peter's for Ash Wednesday: 8am, 10.30am & 6pm Masses in St Paul's Church: 10am & 7.30pm

On **Sunday** evenings of Lent, Evening Prayer of the Church (from the Divine Office) will be prayed in St Peter's at 7pm, followed by Benediction.

On **Tuesday** evenings of Lent during 7pm Mass, guest speakers will talk about pastoral/caring work undertaken by organisations within our community to which they belong.

On **Friday** evenings of Lent, immediately after 7pm Mass, Stations of the Cross will be led by young people from the Pope John Paul Award Programme
