Will continue in St Peter's and will be held every first and last Monday of the month in the Upper Sacristy at 7.00pm.

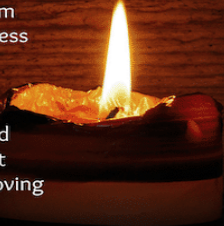
Also, in St Paul's, it will be held on the first and last Tuesday of every month after 10.00am Mass
