Clonduff, and uncle of this evening's lecturer. Fr Keenan was a World War I Army Chaplain. The lecture will focus on the background to the Great War and the attitude of the Catholic Church to it. Francis Keenan will consider the response of the Irish Church to this devastating conflict, a response that culminated in the eventual participation of priests from our diocese as Army Chaplains.
