Mass for Recently Deceased
'Let us remember them.'
There will be Mass for deceased parishioners whose deaths occurred between 1 November 2022 and 31 October 2023 on Tuesday 14th November at 7pm.
At this Mass a representative from each bereaved family will be invited to carry an inscribed candle to the Sanctuary. There will be prayers for both the deceased and the bereaved.
Bereaved parishioners, where a relative's death took place outside of St Peter's Parish during this period, are also welcome to have their loved one's name included. It is important that these names are made known to the Parish Office by Friday 10th November to be included.

The Diocese of Dromore has published the Report of the Second Review of Child Safeguarding Practice in the Diocese undertaken by the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland at the invitation of Archbishop Eamon Martin, Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese.
The Review process, which began in March 2023, assessed compliance with Safeguarding Children Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland, 2016. The Reviewers also looked at governance arrangements in the Diocese and any opportunities for learning and development.
In response to the report Archbishop Martin said "we are very much aware of the terrible wrong done to innocent children in the past and we are doing everything in our power to prevent anything like that happening again. I encourage everyone to read the Review report in full and to be vigilant to ensure that the Diocese remains fully committed to safeguarding today and in the future."

Safeguarding survey for survivors of abuse
The Irish Bishops' Conference, along with the Association of Leaders of Missionaries and Religious of Ireland, have commissioned consultants, RSM Ireland, to undertake a review of child safeguarding in the Catholic Church. One part of this review is to engage with survivors and victims of abuse, to seek their views on Church Safeguarding processes. Specifically, RSM would like to hear from survivors who have disclosed abuse within the last twenty years, to see what needs to be improved.
