The Dougher Cemetery is the final resting place of Labour Corps personnel from World War One listed on 'The Unremembered' database. Members of St Peter's & St Paul's community are encouraged to respond to the Big Ideas 'Remember Together' programme by exploring and sharing stories from the local community to commemorate the First World War in 2018.

Groups of at least eight people can apply for small-scale funding to create Remembrance activities in the lead up to the Centenary of Armistice this November. Applications are currently being accepted. The Unremembered project commemorates the Labour Corps, who came from across the Commonwealth and beyond. Many died, yet today their contribution and sacrifice is rarely acknowledged.
Groups could apply for funding to cover costs associated with making a commemorative wreath, or using The Unremembered database to find local Labour Corps graves and discover little-known local heritage which could be shared in a talk, for example. The Unremembered map is also available for groups to learn about the history of the different Labour Corps from across the world.
