Dear Parishioners

I want to acknowledge the very generous contributions made by St Peter's Parish to peoples in poor and developing parts of our world in recent months. The *Trocaire Lenten Campaign* was very widely supported and from Trocaire boxes returned and donations received, in the weeks following Easter, the parish was able to forward £16,310 to Trocaire last month. As the government was committed to matching Trocaire donations in 2016 'pound for pound', our parish contribution will effectively have a value of over £30,000 to Trocaire's various overseas development projects. Trocaire are deeply grateful to the parishioners of St Peter's for your wonderful support of them, once again, this year.
