\* offer a prayer of your choice for the Pope's intentions.


Then an indulgence may be gained as follows:  
a) From noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November, by visiting a church or chapel and praying one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed.  
b) Once per day from 1-8 November, by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead.

Feel free to choose (a) or (b) or both. By these prescribed ways, God's mercy is poured on those who need it most. Our communion with the Holy Souls means they gratefully return prayers for you.
