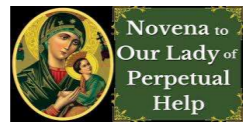

## ST COLMAN'S CEMETERY

### CEMETERY POLICY

As available space becomes a premium in St Colman's cemetery the following decision(s) has/have been taken to 'protect' what burial space there is available for those who live in the parishes of St Peter and St Paul, Lurgan.

From January 2025 the price of a single grave plot will be £325

From January 2025 the price of a double grave plot will be £850 (and these will only be granted in extreme circumstances as decided by the Parish Finance Council). No grave plots will be able to be 'prior bought'. They will only be available as and when required.

Families/individuals who do not live in either of the parishes of St Peter's or St Paul's, but have previously purchased burial plots (and have proof of purchase) may be interred in St Colman's Cemetery.

No new burial plots will be sold to people from outside the parish for burial in St Colman's cemetery (even if they have prior connections with the parish e.g. baptised, confirmed, married or through family ties).

If any issues arise with regards to the cemeteries, the final decision will rest with the Parish Priest.
