Tom died a young man, in 1918, of wounds received towards the end of World War I, and is interred in St Mary's, Derrytrasna. Father Denis, a heroic missionary in Burma during World War II, died in January 1993, and is buried in Dalgan Park, Co Meath. Four speakers will outline the lives and travails of the two brothers who distinguished themselves with valour and
