WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES FINAL PAPAL MASS

Tickets for Pope Francis' final Mass at 3pm on Sunday 26 August in Phoenix Park, Dublin are being snapped up at a rate of 30,000 per day. 440,000 tickets have already been allocated, and organisers tell us availability of tickets will soon come to an end. If you plan on attending and have no ticket yet, please book now. Free tickets for this event are now available from www.worldmeeting2018.ie. Your ticket will be sent to you by email closer to the event.

The Mass is a free event but you will need a ticket to gain entry. Every adult and every child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections. More useful information on planning your trip to Dublin or Knock is available at www.gov.ie/en/visit-of-pope-francis, or at www.translink.co.uk/popeinireland.

Tickets are no longer available for the Congress in the RDS, for Croke Park or for Knock.
