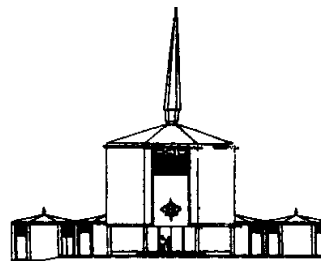

Our second month of collecting for Craigavon food bank has been a great success. We donated a fantastic 172kg/27 st of items. For the month of June the shopping list remains the same ; tinned meat, tinned tomatoes, tinned fruit, tinned potatoes, cooking sauces, rice, UHT milk, coffee/tea, tinned pudding/custard, fruit juice (long life), snacks/jam and toiletries/nappies. At the moment the food bank does not need breakfast cereal or baked beans.
