

As parishioners will be aware, we are celebrating this year, the Fiftieth Anniversary of St. Paul's Church.

The Foundation stone for the Church was laid in September 1963 and St. Paul's was practically completed by December 1965.

It was used for Masses since the Fourth Sunday of Advent that year. The Church was solemnly dedicated and officially opened by Bishop O'Doherty on Sunday 17th April, 1966. Cardinal William Conway attended this ceremony. Several photographs of that historic day are included in the 2016 commemorative calendar which was

produced by the parish last Christmas.

To mark the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the solemn dedication itself, Bishop McAreavey will celebrate the 12 noon Mass in St. Paul's Church, next Sunday 17th April. All parishioners are warmly welcome to join the Bishop for this Mass of Thanksgiving.

We give thanks at this time – as the parish community of St. Paul's – for the gift that this Church building has been for local people, and for all who have been part of Catholic life in Lurgan, during the past five decades.
