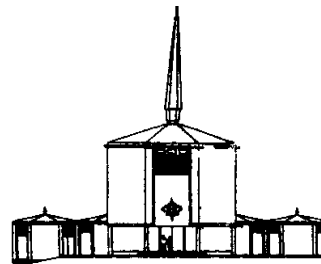

DROMORE DIOCESAN HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Monday, 11th September.

The Society's Annual General Meeting will be held at 6.50 pm in St. Peter's Parish Centre, North Street, Lurgan.

This event coincides with the 40th Anniversary of the Society's foundation in Canon Bernard Treanor's parochial house in Finnis, Dromara, in 1977. Following the A.G.M., a lecture titled, "Trasna's Ancient Origins: Clanbrassil McAlinden: Sons & A Swansong to War," to be given by Jim Conway, Lurgan. The lecture will be of special interest to the McAlinden, Haughian, O'Neill, Hogan, Harte, Conway and Seeley families. The lecturer will trace the search for four McAlinden brothers, their ancestors, and their sacrifices during World War I.

Parishioners are most welcome. Preparations are underway for publication in the late autumn of a commemorative journal to mark the first phase of the Society's life. 1977 – 1999.
