# **FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK** Tuesday 12th September - The Most

Holy Name of Mary - This feast was included in the Roman Calendar in 1684 to celebrate the victory over the Turks at Vienna in 1683.

St Ailbe is sometimes claimed as one of the pre-Patrician saints but the annals note his death in 528 He founded the monastery of Emly which became very important in Munster.

# Wednesday 13th September - St John

Chrysostom, one of the four great Greek Doctors, the 'Golden-mouthed preacher was Archbishop of Constantinople. He incurred much and died in exile. Patron saint of preachers.

# Thursday 14th September - The

**Exaltation of the Holy Cross - The** discovery of the True Cross is dated to 14 September 320. On 13 September 335 the churches on Calvary were dedicated and the cross that St Helena was discovered and venerated there the next day.

# Friday 15 September - Our Lady of

Sorrows Mary, standing by the cross, 'suffered intensely with her only begotten son and united herself as his Mother to his sacrifice, consenting with love to the offering of the victim who was born of her', whom she also offered to the eternal Father.
