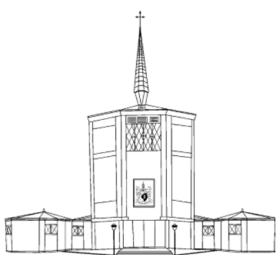

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Tuesday 13 June - St Anthony of Padua, priest and doctor of the Church

- St Anthony lived for a time in France, but chiefly in Italy, and died at Padua in 1231 at age 36, with the reputation of great sanctity. From the day of his death innumerable miracles caused the faithful to invoke him as a wonderworker of untiring benevolence. Anthony is one of the most popular saints in the Church.

Wednesday 14 June St Davnet, Virgin

- lived and died at Tydavnet at Sliabh Beagh Co Monaghan. Tradition speaks of St Davnet as a virgin and found of a Church or monastery.

Friday 16 June - The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus:

World day of prayer for priests. "Sacred heart of Jesus" denotes the entire mystery of Christ: Son of God.

Saturday 17 June The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary

- day following solemnity of Sacred Heart. The contiguity of both celebrations is in itself a liturgical sign of their close connection: the mystery of the Heart of Jesus is projected onto and reverberates in the Heart of his mother, who is also one of his followers and a disciple.

FIRST CLASS RELIC OF BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS, TO VISIT ST PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL, IN THIS THE 150TH YEAR SINCE THE DEDICATION OF THE CATHEDRAL

A first-class relic of Blessed Carlo will visit the Cathedral from Sunday 11 - Tuesday 13 June 2023. Blessed Carlo was beatified by Pope Francis in Assisi in October 2020. His friends remember him as a young dreamer, service-oriented and full of charisma. He died in 2006, at only 15 years of age, after a battle with leukaemia. His life may have been short but it made a huge impact. Recently, in the process for the teenager's beatification, his tomb became a real pilgrimage site.
