

We are blessed to have the relics of a family of Saints from Lisieux in Ireland for the World Meeting of Families. The most famous member of the family is the daughter known as the Little Flower, St Thérèse of the Child Jesus. Her parents, Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, were also canonised in 2015, and the relics of all three are travelling together to selected locations in Ireland in preparation for the WMOF.

Ss Louis and Zélie are patron saints of the World Meeting.

The relics of the Martin family remind us that we are all called to be saints in our family life, a goal very much within our grasp with God's help. The visit of their relics encourages us to live to our best in our families, living the kind of life God asks of us.
