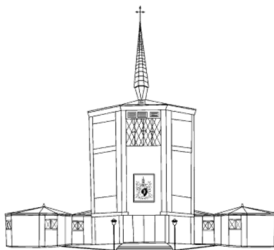

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

FRIDAYS DURING LENT AFTER 10 AM MASS

The Stations of the Cross depict 14 events in the Passion of Jesus Christ, beginning with Jesus being condemned to death and ending with His body being laid in a tomb.

The practice of praying the Stations of the Cross originated in medieval Europe when pilgrims were unable to visit the Holy Land, so instead "visited" these Holy places through prayer. St. Francis of Assisi, the founder of the Franciscan order, authored Stations of the Cross that popularized the devotion throughout the world. Today, you'll find Stations of the Cross in almost every Catholic Church, particularly prayed on Lenten Fridays, but available throughout the year for meditation and reflection.

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St Peter's and St Paul's,
Please see below the instructions for downloading the latest version of our Parish App by going directly to the App Store or Google Play Store.

Open the **App Store** on your Apple device or the **Play Store** on your Android device.
In the search bar, **type Parish365**
Look out for the church icon(see above)in the search results.
Press **Get** or **Install**.

Open the app and connect to our parish by clicking the **+** button.
Enter the town name when prompted - **Lurgan**.
Click **'Continue'** to see St Peter's and St Paul's.
Tick here and click the **Save** icon in top right corner.

Choose your Profile to receive notifications on your device.
Tick the option box for St Peter's Parishioner and/or St Paul's Parishioner and any other areas of interest eg Funeral Information
Then click the **save icon** in top right corner.
When asked if you wish to allow Notifications, click **'Yes'** or **'Allow'**.
(some listed categories are for specific Parish Groups to receive notifications and require a known password to proceed.
