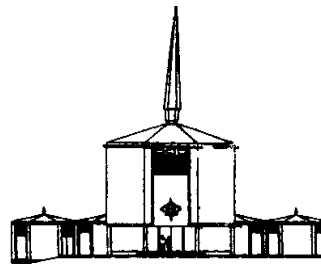

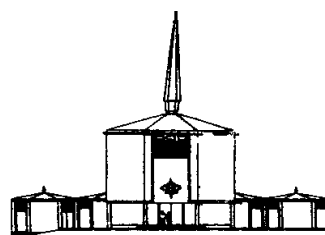

Frank McCorry's final book will be launched at 7 pm in
Lurgan Library on Tuesday evening, 21st November.

The well-illustrated book comprises 275 pages with twelve
chapters and two postscripts. Chapter One is
autobiographical. A wide range of Early Christian and
medieval ecclesiastical sites in the sub-region that borders on
the southern shore of Lough Neagh in Counties Armagh,
Antrim and Down are explored. In the secular sphere, there
are chapters and sections devoted to Lurgan, The Montiaghs,
the Great Famine and the Workhouse and to John Hancock's
Letter-Book. Parishioners most welcome.

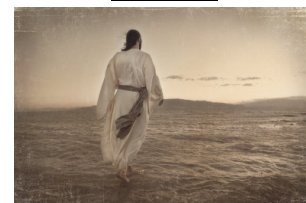

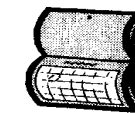


of our dear departed ones
