# **FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK**

Monday 14 August - St Maximilian

Kolbe, priest and martyr 1894-1941 a Conventual Franciscan who worked in the apostolate of the press in Poland and Japan, and died in Auschwitz

Tuesday 15 August - The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary honours the fullness of blessedness that was her destiny, the glorification of her immaculate soul and virginal body that conformed her to the risen Christ.

Wednesday 16 August - St Stephen of Hungary, 975-1038, first King of Hungary and its patron saint, worked for the conversion of his people to Christianity.

# Thursday 17 August - Our Lady of

Knock, the story began in August 1879 when Our Lady, St Joseph and St John the Evangelist appeared at the south gable of Knock Parish Church. This miraculous apparition was witnessed by fifteen people, young and old. Knock is an internationally recognized Marian Shrine. Saint John Paul II visited Knock as part of his 1979 papal pilgrimage to Ireland.

# Saturday 19th August – St John Eudes,

1601-80, from Normandy, France, spent a fruitful twenty years with the French Oratory, then left to found a congregation to improve the standards of the clergy through seminaries. He founded also the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity and Refuge. He promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart.
