#### POPE ON MEDUGORJE **PILGRIMAGES**

Pope Francis has decided to authorise pilgrimages to Medugorje, which can now be officially organised by dioceses and parishes and will no longer take place only in a private capacity which has so far been the case.

A Vatican spokesman specified that the papal authorisation must be accompanied by "care to prevent these pilgrimages from being interpreted as an authentication of known events, which still require examination by the Church." He went on, "Considering the considerable flow of people who go to Medugorje and the abundant fruits of grace that have sprung from it, this authorisation is part of the particular pastoral attention that the Holy Father intended to give to [the people who go on pilgrimage], aimed at encouraging and promoting the fruits of good."
