

WMOF: FINAL PAPAL MASS

Now that Pope Francis' itinerary is confirmed, we are told that Single Day Tickets for Pope Francis at Knock and at the Final Mass in Dublin are free and will be available from the WMOF website on 25 June 2018.

You will need a free ticket for the events with Pope Francis at the Phoenix Park. Dublin or Our Lady's Shrine, Knock.

From Monday 25 June, book your ticket through www.worldmeeting2018.ie. Your ticket will be sent to you by email closer to the event.

The Mass is a free event but you will need a ticket to gain entry. Every adult and every child attending will need a ticket Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections.

Tickets for other events at WMOF already available through the website.

It is not possible to apply for tickets for both Phoenix Park and the Knock events, as these events are on the same day—you may only apply for one of these events.

**Dromore Diocesan Historical Society** Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> June. Parishioners most welcome.

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2018. @ 2:30pm Field trip to the McMahon farm (Grid Ref J 0056150), Charlestown Road, Derrytagh South Derrytrasna, six miles N of Lurgan. The farm overlooks Lough Gullion, once a 300-acre lake drained, temporarily by Charles Brownlow, later lord Lurgan, in the period 1828-1833. Frank McCorry will speak about a recently discovered burial ground nearby and provide a detailed account of the engineering project undertaken by Brownlow and Scottish engineer Alexander Nimmo and a team of local labourers.

The farm, with parking for about 30 cars, is approached by a narrow well-surfaced lane. No parking in the lane; please follow directions of stewards.
