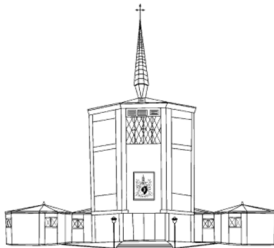

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Tuesday 20 June - The Irish Martyrs
17 Irish Martyrs, men, women, cleric and lay put to death for the Catholic faith between 1579 and 1654 were beatified by Pop John Paul II in 1992.

Wednesday 21 June - St Aloysius Gonzaga, joined the Jesuits. As a model novice he worked in the plague hospital and caught the fever, dying in 1591 at the age of 23. He is the patron of youth.

Thursday 22 June St Paulinus of Nola, Bishop and Saints John Fisher and Thomas More Bishop and Martyrs. Bishop of Nola and Campania. St John Fisher built Christ's and St John's Colleges Cambridge. His love of truth brought about his death.

St Thomas More, the first commoner to be Lord Chancellor of England, suffered martyrdom under Henry VIII. Patron of lawyers and those in public life.

Saturday 24 June The Nativity of St John the Baptist - We rejoice at the coming of St John the Baptist, a man of self-denial, integrity of life and purpose and an uncompromising prophetic voice. John means 'The Lord has shown favour'. This feast related to the summer solstice when the days begin to grow shorter calling John's words, "He must increase but I must decrease".
