

Bishop McAreavey has, in recent days, appointed Fr. McConville to take charge of the Parishes of Dromore and Magheralin. Fr. Conor will be leaving St. Paul's and St. Peter's Parishes soon, to take up his new duties and will move to live in Kilwarlin.

Notice From Bishop John McAreavey

Across the diocese of Dromore, people will be aware of a reduction in the number of priests available to serve in the parishes of the diocese.

In 2005 there were 41 priests serving in parishes; today there are 23 diocesan priests, supported by 3 Polish priests and 3 Permanent Deacon. It is now essential to review the allocation of priests in the parishes of the diocese.

Beginning in September, a process of consultation will be carried out, involving clergy and parishioners.

Enrolment for 2016-2018 is currently taking place. Two courses being offered:

Pathways— offers space for reflection and study. It offers participants spiritual and theological formation, in order to explore their faith with greater confidence.

(No qualifications necessary.) This two-year
