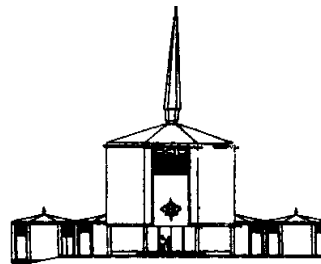

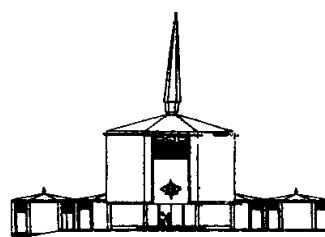

Book Launch

"Driving Slowly Down Country Lanes: Landscape, Society & Worship in East Ulster, A Personal Perspective"

Frank McCorry's final book will be launched at 7 pm in Lurgan Library on Tuesday evening, 21st November.

The well-illustrated book comprises 275 pages with twelve chapters and two postscripts. Chapter One is autobiographical. A wide range of Early Christian and medieval ecclesiastical sites in the sub-region that borders on the southern shore of Lough Neagh in Counties Armagh, Antrim and Down are explored. In the secular sphere, there are chapters and sections devoted to Lurgan, The Montiagh, the Great Famine and the Workhouse and to John Hancock's Letter-Book. *Parishioners most welcome.*

Dromore Diocese Strategic Working Group

Earlier this year, Bishop McAreevey shared his concerns on the future of Dromore Diocese. A Diocesan Strategic Working Group (DSWG) was set up to review the pastoral life of Dromore Diocese during this time of profound change. The Group have met in September & October and expectations are they will remain as a working group until summer 2018. Currently the group are in the research phase of the work, which involves discussion, prayer, continuous engagement with the Clergy, listening and reflection. They have secured the assistance of Mr Bobby Moore, Organisational Development Facilitator to work with them in creating the Diocesan future plans to ensure we make vibrant and vital faith communities that are sustainable for the long run. The Group are planning to meet in December and an update will follow early in the New Year. 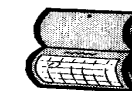
