child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections.

A LITTLE PRAYER

(IT SEEMS PRAYER STILL UPSETS PEOPLE)

When Minister Joe Wright was asked to open the new session, everyone was expecting the usual generalities, but this is what they heard:

Heavenly Father, we come before you today to ask forgiveness and to seek Your direction and guidance. We know Your Word says "Woe to those who call evil good"

We have lost our spiritual equilibrium and reversed our values. We confess that we have ridiculed the absolute truth of Your Word and called it Pluralism. We have exploited the poor and called it the lottery. We have rewarded laziness and called it welfare.

We have killed our unborn and called it choice. We have shot abortionists and called it justifiable. We have neglected to discipline our children and called it building self-esteem. We have abused power and called it politics. We have coveted our neighbour's possessions and called it ambition.

We have polluted the air with profanity and pornography and called it freedom of statement. We have ridiculed the time-honoured values of our forefathers and called it enlightenment.

Search us Oh God and know our hearts today; cleanse us from every sin and set us free. Guide and bless these men and women who have been sent to direct us to the centre of Your will and we openly ask these things in the name of Your Son, the Living Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amen.

The response was immediate. A number of legislators walked our during the prayer in protest. In 6 short weeks, Central Christian Church, where Joe Wright is Pastor, logged more than 5,000 phone calls with only 47 of those calls responding negatively. The Church is now receiving international requests of this prayer from India, Africa and Korea. Commentator Paul Harvey aired this Prayer on his radio programme "The Rest Of The Story" and has received a larger response to this programme than any other he has ever aired.
