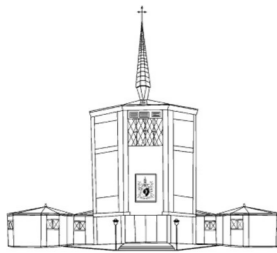

Working for a just world.

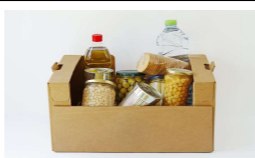
