The pack will contain an access code for completing online or details on how to request

a paper form. Your answers are important and completely confidential. Your personal data will never be shared. As soon as you receive your pack you can complete your census.

Here you can find out about the support available to help you complete including quidance in Braille, Easy Read, British and Irish Sign Language and large print questionnaires.
