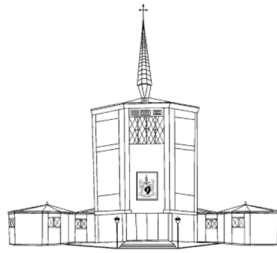


# SAINT PAUL'S PARISH, SHANKILL
