

### John Paul II Award Pilgrimage To Rome

The John Paul II Award is in its 10th year.

To celebrate this event a pilgrimage to Rome has been organised where it is hoped we will be honoured with a private audience with Pope Francis.

29<sup>th</sup> Oct. – 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov. or 30<sup>th</sup> Oct. – 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov. You will be part of a national group of 450 plus leaders. Total cost €650, includes accommodation, flights and travel insurance. Book your place with £100 deposit on or before 30<sup>th</sup> January. Places are limited, so book early.

This pilgrimage is for those aged 18 and over who have completed the JPII Award since 2007, or parish leaders/volunteers who have supported our young people to participate in and complete their award.
