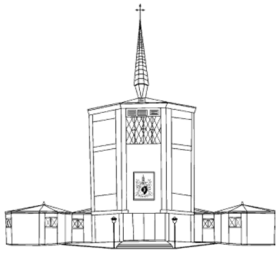

FEAST DAYS DURING THE WEEK

Monday 24th April - St Fidelis of Sigmaringen, Priest and Martyr. A Capuchin who preaches to the Calvinists in Switzerland, where he was killed by a group of extremists.

Tuesday 25th April - St Mark, Evangelist He was closely connected with the preaching of Saints Peter, Paul and Barnabas. His Gospel was probably written at Rome when he was with Paul and is traditionally viewed as representing St Peter's approach to the preaching of the good news.

Thursday 27th April - St Asicus, Bishop. The Ethiopian official was humble enough to ask to have the scriptures explained to him. Philip's opening up of the word of God brought the man to faith and baptism. We to also ought to search the scriptures daily.

Friday 28th April - St Peter Chanel is honoured as the first martyr of the Church in Oceania.

Saturday 29th April - St Catherine of Siena. Humble and dauntless who brought peace to her native Siena to Italy and fourteenth century Europe.
