produce a Diocesan Development Plan.

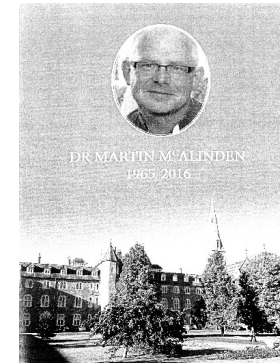
