FEAST OF ST PETER AND ST PAUL

Saint Peter and Saint Paul Day is observed every year on June 29. The event is the liturgical feast day that honours two martyrs of the Christian faith, St. Peter died by crucifixion and St. Paul by beheading. Although the church acknowledges they may not have been executed at the same time, both met death at the command of the Roman emperor – Nero. The date chosen is the traditional anniversary of their death and martyrdom. The event is a significant religious occasion in Rome, and the catholic. Parishes around the world hold masses to commemorate the day.

NEW DEBIT CARD/CREDIT CARD MACHINE FACILITY

For parishioners/visitors who wish to donate to our parish (Saint Paul's, Lurgan) by using their debit card or visa card, please follow the instructions below:

1. Select the amount you would like to donate to your parish.
2. Simply tap the machine to make a contactless donation (not the screen) or alternatively you can insert your card into the machine with your pin.
3. Select the button 'Yes' or 'No' which asks you if you wish to Gift Aid your donation. **Please note that if you wish to Gift Aid your donation you will need your type in your personal details.**
4. Your transaction will be confirmed on the keypad and the screen will return to normal.

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Tuesday 27 June - St Cyril of Alexandria, bishop and doctor of the Church - St Cyril 376-444, patriarch of Alexandria, fought against Nestorianism at the Council of Ephesus, 431 which proclaimed Mary, the Mother of God.

Wednesday 28 June - St Irenaeus Bishop and martyr - lived just after the time of the apostles and knew those who had seen and talked with them. He became Bishop of Lyons. The desire to win people to Christianity by love rather than by fear, was apparent in all of Irenaeus' work.

Thursday 29 June - St Peter and Paul

Friday 30 June - The First Martyrs of Rome, in addition to St Peter and St Paul, died under Nero in the year 64.

Saturday 1st July St Oliver Plunkett, bishop and martyr - He was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669 and ministered there but was forced work in a covert way during the suppression of priests. He was found guilty of high treason for promoting the Catholic faith and was hanged on 1 July 1681 at Tyburn, London. He was canonized by Pope Paul VI on 12 October 1975, his head is venerated in St Peter's Church, Drogheda.
