(To focus the great message of the Passion: forgiveness)

A Jew wrote the following prayer on a piece of wrapping paper just before entering the gas chamber during the Holocaust.

Lord, when you enter your glory, do not remember only people of good will. Remember those also of ill will. Do not remember their cruelty and their violence.

Instead, be mindful of the fruits we bore of what they did to us. *Remember the patience of some and the courage* of others.
