On Suffering - 'Suffering is somehow the inheritance of those who strive for the highest and most noble goals.

### **FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK** Monday 26 May - St Philip Neri

Priest founded the Congregation of the Oratory to foster good preaching and to promote holiness of priestly life.

Tuesday May 27 - St Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop was a monk in Rome when sent by Pope Gregory the Great to preach to the English.

Thursday 29 May St Paul VI, Pope: born 1897. Ordained priest 29 May 1920 and worked in Vatican for most of the time before becoming archbishop of Milan in 1954. Elected Pope in 1963, taking the name Paul VI, succeeding John XXIII, he continued the second Vatican Council. A messenger of peace, he sought to pen the Church to the modern world: he began the papal apostolic visits. He was Beatified in 2014, canonised 2018, his memorial is on the anniversary of his priestly ordination.
