

## Farewell to Fr McConville

Fr Conor McConville begins, this coming week, a new phase in his priestly ministry as he moves to take charge of the Parishes of Dromore and Magheralin. We wish him well in his new roles. Living in Kilwarlin and being still close to the Lurgan/Craigavon areas, Fr Conor will continue to be a chaplain to St Ronan's College and will also continue to serve, at times, as an 'on-call' priest for Craigavon Area Hospital.

Fr Conor came to St Peter's and St Paul's Parishes in October 2012, having previously served for several years in Newry. A native of Freecrow, within St Peter's Parish, he was already well known across this town. Fr Conor's thorough knowledge of Lurgan and his natural affinity with its people were significant strengths to him in his pastoral ministry here, these past four years. Many have experienced and been enriched by his devoted ministry in both Lurgan parishes. Constant and persevering in his approach to his priestly duties, wherever he has served, Fr Conor is widely admired for his down-to-earth approach to life and for the honesty and integrity that he brings to his dealings with others, whatever the circumstances. He will be greatly missed by the people of Lurgan and by the clergy whom he has worked alongside here. May the Lord bless and protect him in his new surroundings, in the times ahead.

## Changes to Mass/Confessions schedule in St. Paul's Parish

Dear Parishioners

With Fr McConville's going from Lurgan and our reliance upon three priests for both St Paul's and St Peter's Parishes - at least in the short term - I find it necessary to make some changes to the weekly Mass/Confessions schedule. With one less priest available, I primarily want to avoid the continuing of situations where a similar service is being provided at more or less the same time in both parishes. For this reason I would like to like to change the morning Mass time for Saturdays in St Paul's Parish from 10am to 10.30am, beginning Saturday 8th October. Funerals on Saturdays will become part of this 10.30am Mass. Daily Mass will continue to be celebrated in St Paul's at 10am, Monday to Friday. From this same date onwards, Saturday morning Confessions in St Paul's will be heard from 11am-11.30am, rather than before the morning Mass. There will also be a slight adjustment to the 'First Thursday' evening Confession time in St Paul's, which is detailed below. I hope parishioners will be able to adapt, relatively easily, to these new arrangements in the weeks ahead. I really regret that changes have to be made at all and I thank everyone for their understanding and cooperation.

From Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> October onwards, **Saturday** morning Mass will be celebrated in St Paul's Church at **10.30am** (rather than 10am). Mass will continue to be celebrated at 10am, Monday-Friday.

From October onwards, 10.30am Mass will no longer be celebrated in St Peter's Parish on Mondays, Wednesdays & Thursdays. 8am Mass will continue, Monday-Friday, and 7pm Mass on Tuesdays & Fridays.

From Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> October onwards, Saturday morning Confessions will be heard in St Paul's Church from **11am-11.30am** (rather than before the morning Mass). Saturday evening Confessions continue, unchanged, before the 7pm Vigil Mass in St Paul's.

**First Thursday of the month** Confessions will continue to be heard in St Paul's Church, though at the slightly amended time of **6.15pm-6.50pm** (rather than 6.30pm-7pm), from Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> October.

From Friday 7th October onwards, Confessions will be heard EVERY Friday evening in St Peter's Parish, from 6.15-6.50pm. Saturday morning Confessions, however, will not be continuing in St Peter's. Confessions will continue, unchanged, before the 6pm Vigil Mass on Saturday evenings in St Peter's. First Thursday Confessions will be continuing in St Paul's Parish only.
