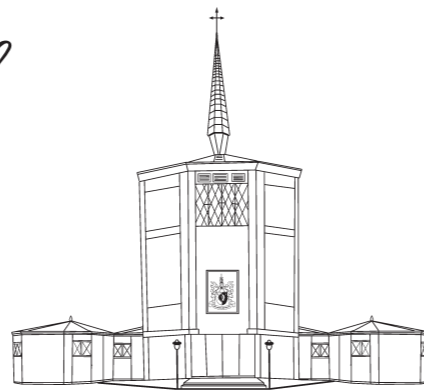
We extend a warm welcome to all who attend our Church.
