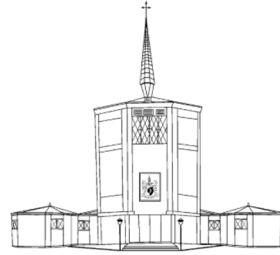

Baptisms take place in St Paul's on the second and fourth Sunday of each month. St Peter's on the first, third and fifth Sunday of each month.
One month's notice is required for both Churches.

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 28 October Saint Simon and Jude The teaching of the apostles is the living gospel for all to hear. Their authority comes from their fidelity to Christ and his message. St Jude is the patron saint of hopeless causes.
Tuesday 29th October St Colman, Bishop - hailed from Kilmacduagh, Co Galway in the seventh century. After studying in Aran, where he founded two church in Inis Mór he returned to make a foundation at Kilmacduagh.
Thursday 31 October - Blessed Dominic Collins, Martyr he was born around 1566 in Youghal Co Cork. After a career in the military he entered the Society of Jesus as a Brother. He was captured by the English who tried in vain to make him adjure his faith. He was hanged in his native city on 31 October 1602.
Friday 1 November - The Feast of All Saints The ultimate object of veneration of the Sains is the glory of God and the sanctification of man by conforming one's life full to the divine will and by imitating the virtue of those who were preeminent disciples of the Lord.
Saturday 2 November: All Souls Commemoration of the Faithful Departed. Belief in the resurrection of the dead is an essential part of Christian revelation. It implies a particular understanding of the ineluctable mystery of death.
