Monday 29 April - St Catherine of Siena. Humble and dauntless who brought peace to her native Siena to Italy and fourteenth century Europe.

Tuesday 30 April - St Pius V Pope

1504-72. Dominican, elected pope in 1565, he implemented the reforms of the Council of Trent, including the Breviary, Missal and catechism. He is noted for his defence of Christendom against the Ottoman empire.

Wednesday 1 May - St Joseph

Patron of Workers. The feast, instituted by Pope Pius XII in 1955, proposes the example and intercession of St Joseph as worker and patron of workers. On this date many countries celebrate the dignity of human

Thursday 2 May - St Athanasius, bishop and doctor of the Church.

Born at Alexandria around 295, he fought ceaselessly against the Arian heresy, defending the true and equal divinity of Christ.

Friday 3 May - SS Philip and James

Apostles. St Philip asked to see and having seen he tells the good news to others. Formerly a disciple of John the Baptist he became a follower of Christ.

St James - He converted many of the people of Jerusalem to the faith and was martyred in the year 62.

Saturday 4 May - St Conleth, Bishop

of Kildare. While living as a hermit he was persuaded by Brigid to act as priest for her community in Kildare.
