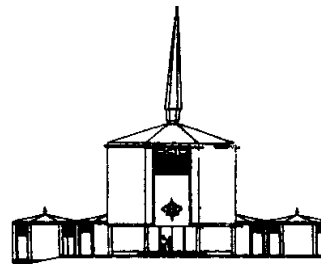

Jubilee of Mercy

24 Hours For The Lord

Pope Francis, in proclaiming this Jubilee Year of Mercy, has asked that local Church communities would set aside "24 hours for the Lord" next Friday/Saturday 4 – 5 March. This is intended to be a time of continuous prayer, with an opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

In response to this call, the Lurgan parishes are organising a Vigil of Prayer at

St. Paul's Church
next Friday, 4th March, from 7pm
through until Saturday, 5th March, at 7pm.

St. Paul's Church will be open all throughout this period of time (overnight) and parishioners are welcome to visit at any time during these hours for private prayer and devotion.

Two priests will be available at all times for those who wish to avail of Confession, or to pray/chat with a priest. During the daytime hours, some priests will be helping from neighbouring parishes.

There will be certain times of common (public) prayer. Again, parishioners are welcome to visit and join in these times of prayer. The schedule is as follows:

9pm: Divine Mercy Chaplet **11pm:** Night Prayer

6.15pm: Evening Prayer & Benediction **7pm:** Vigil Mass

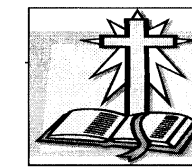
