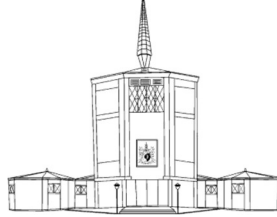


# SAINT PAUL'S PARISH, SHANKILL

**FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK**  
**Monday 29 July - Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus,** welcomed Jesus as a family friend. Martha generously offered him hospitality. Mary listened attentively to his words and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of the One who humiliated death.  
**Tuesday 30 July - St Peter Chrysologus** died c 450, Bishop of Ravenna, famous for his preaching.  
**Wednesday 31 July - St Ignatius of Loyola, Priest,** from the North of Spain, founded the Society of Jesus. By the time of his death, the Society had spread widely and had over one thousand members. His great theme was the service of God and God's greater glory. The experience of his conversion led to his writing of the Spiritual Exercises.  
**Thursday 1 August - St Alphonsus Ligouri, bishop and doctor of the Church** – Founder of Redemptorist Congregation, taught much on moral theology and spiritual life. He is remembered as a popular preacher and influential writer of theology.  
**Friday 2 August - St Eusebius of Vercelli, Bishop and St Peter Julian Eymard Priest** a fervent disciple of the Eucharistic Mystery established the Blessed Sacrament Fathers and with the help of Marguerite Guillot, the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament.
