We are glad to announce that there can be a cautious return to public worship. That means they will be open for Mass on Palm Sunday and for the great Triduum of Prayer from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday.

A warm welcome back to our Parishioners. We propose to have St Peter's & St Paul's open for the limited number of people who can safely attend with social distancing in place. When the congregation reaches the safe, recognized number of places the doors will be closed.

Families are encouraged to join those celebrating the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus in Churches, from the 'domestic church' of their own living rooms, via live-streaming.

Holy Week: Masses at 10.00am on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Divine Mercy will be said at 9.45am on Tuesday morning and the Holy Hour on Wednesday Evening at 7.00pm.
