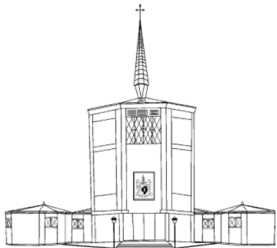

Letters as treasured personal mementoes. Parishioners are cordially invited to the launch of Booklet III (44 Pages) compiled by Frank McCorry, titled, "The legacy of a Passing Generation: letters from Friends; correspondence received during the period 1979 to 2022".

A two-part booklet; Part One contains a series of insightful and delightful edited letters sent to the author, 1984-2012 by an erudite First Generation Migrant, a genealogist, dwelling in Pittsburg, USA with deep roots in the Derrytrasna area. FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 29 May - The Blessed

Virgin Mary Mother of God

From the cross Jesus entrusted Mary to his disciples as their mother and entrusted his disciples to Mary as her children. Mary, present with the disciples at Pentecost prayed with them as the Holy Spirit descended. Mary has never ceased to take motherly care of the pilgrim Church on earth.

Tuesday 30 May - Generosity in the service of the Lord is rewarded. Token sacrifices are not enough, there has to be a complete giving, with cheerful heart. Leaving everything to follow church brings its own reward.

Wednesday 31 May - The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Today's liturgy recalls the 'Blessed Virgin Mary carrying her Son within her' and visiting Elizabeth to offer charitable assistance and to proclaim the mercy of God the Saviour.

Thursday 1 June - St Justin, Martyr
Was born in the Holy Land and settled in Rome. He became a Christian and is remembered for his defence of Christian belief and practice. He was martyred c.165.

Friday 2 June St Marcellinus and Peter, Martyrs

Praise is due for our ancestors in the faith in whom the Lord takes delight. The Church cherishes the memory of the holy men and women whose generosity in the service of Christ has enriched us.

Saturday May 3 June - St Kevin

Abbot. A native of Leinster. Wishing to be a hermit, he crossed mountains to Glendalough and settled in Disert Caoimhghin. The monastic settlement grew and spread through the glens.
