Covid-19 restrictions present a major challenge this year, we must keep social distance even when walking and these guidelines must be obeyed at all times.

If not walking, then watch out for our walkers and their blue collection buckets and support our campaign to feed the next hungry child.

Please keep our volunteers and our mission in your prayers.

Saint Paul's Parish warmly everyone is welcome to attend our Weekday and Sunday Masses. At this present time, we have the capacity to accommodate 80 people within our Church. In the event of overcapacity, parishioners can, if they so wish, remain outside, and come into the Church to receive the Blessed Sacrament. Church doors will always remain open when Mass is been celebrated.

The following measures have been introduced for our safety.

- Ushers will greet you at the church entrance and assign you a
- Hand sanitisers are provided. It is necessary to use them at all
- You are invited to make an offering at the entrance to the Church - there is a red box clearing marked for your attention where offertory envelopes and donations can be given. Naturally, in the interest of safety collection baskets will not be passed around.
- Offertory envelopes and donations can also be left into the sacristy with Fionnuala, or at Father Colum's house.
- At present holy water fonts are not in use.
- A one-way system is in operation with clear markings on the floor.
- All seats/pews are marked clearly to allow for social distancing.
- Families from the same household can sit together.
- No congregational singing, this is to keep exhaled droplets in the air to an absolute minimum.
- The Eucharist will be distributed silently, and is to be received at all times in our hand. Naturally, our profession of faith 'the great Amen' will be prayed in unison before Holy Communion.
- Please note that all seats/pews are disinfected daily and after each Mass.
- Unfortunately, the Candle Room and our toilet facilities have to remain closed. Candles are available for purchase at the back of the Church. These candles are to be burned in your home.

We apologise for the inconvenience and disruption that these changes bring about for all of us - but be aware that they have been introduced in line with medical advice as very necessary measures to ensure our utmost safety and wellbeing. Please note that they be reviewed on a very regular basis in line with daily updated advice.
